New Minor Forcing II

Situation

Opener has rebid 1NT after Responder bid 1 of a major; Responder's rebid is an unbid minor.

Objectives:

- 1. Locate a 5-3 fit in Responder's major
- 2. Pinpoint Opener's strength when Responder has invitational values

Responder Requirements:

- ☑ Invitational values (11-12 points) or better

Opener's Rebid Priorities Following New Minor Forcing:

- 1. Show 4-card ♥ suit
- 2. Support Responder's major with 3-card support
- 3. Show strength, 13+ to 14 Support Points, by jumping

After New Minor Forcing Bid, Opener:

- ☑ Alerts (!) Responder's Bid
- ☑ Must Not Pass

Other NMF Situations:

After NMF, Responder's bid at 3-level is Game Forcing:

1♦ - 1♠	AQJ98	
1NT - 2 ♣ !	♥ KT4

3NT	♣ AJT8	

Show 5♠-4♥ weak hands, by a rebid of 2♥ over 1NT. This sequence is not invitational:

1♦ - 1♠	♠ KT652
1NT - 2♥	♥ QT43
Pass	* 8
	♣ J74

With 4-6 weak hands, 4 of major, 6 of "new minor," jump to 3 of "new minor" over 1NT; Opener must pass:

After only the majors have been bid, 2♣! is NMF, 2♦ is a real suit and is a one-round force. After 2♣! Opener uses NMF responses. After 2♦ Opener bids normally; if either partners bids beyond 2NT, it is Game Force.
