Stayman II

This lesson addresses bidding sequences when Partner opens 1NT and Responder is 5-4 in the majors. There are invitational and game forcing sequences.

Responder Holds 5-4 in the Majors

In the following chart, distribution patterns refer to Responder's major holding:

- 5-4 hands with less than invitational values use Jacoby transfers and Pass (give up finding 4-4 fit)
- □ 5-4 invitational hands (8+ to 9) rebid the <u>4-card</u> <u>major</u> when Opener rebids 2◆
- 5-4 game forcing hands (10+ points) jump in the <u>4-</u> <u>card major</u> when Opener rebids 2+ (Smolen)
- □ All 5-5 hands use Jacoby transfers

When you hold a 5-card suit in one major, rebidding the other major 4-card requires an Alert from Partner.
