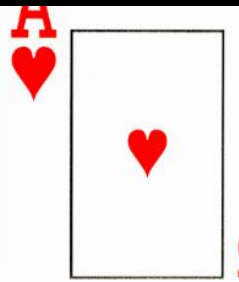

What's your lead? ♥ A

If you're lucky enough to be dealt an outside suit headed by the AK that the opponents have not bid, the Ace is the "conventional" lead.

*When your opening lead is the Ace,  
your partner assumes you have the King.*

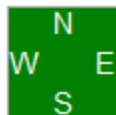

What's your lead? ♥ 9

Versus a NT contract, Ace and King ask Partner to take immediate action when they are made for the opening lead.

*Versus NT contracts:  
Lead 4th best holding AKxxx.  
With greater length, lead the King.*

Declarer cashes the ♣ K and finesses the 9 into your ♣ Q.

Partner leads the ♥ 2, 9, 6, K.

Declarer cashes the ♣ K and finesses the 9 into your ♣ Q.

Hope that Partner has the ♥ A as an entry. Lead the ♠ K communicating you have the Ace and want the suit returned. Now lead the ♥ 4.

*After the opening lead when leading from AKx(x), lead the King.*

You smoothly follow with the 3. If you jump up with the Ace, you have solved Declarer's problem in this suit.

*Make Declarer guess!*
